Just to confirm, children in Key Stage 2 are allowed to bring in, if they would like to, a healthy snack (pieces of fruit, carrot/veg sticks etc. to have at morning break time. The children will need to take their snack out of their lunchbox or bag and put it in the snack basket provided by the class teacher, ready for playtime. It may help if your child's snack is labelled to avoid confusion. Children should not be going to the hall at break times to collect snacks.
